Five tattvas incarnate with Lord Caitanya Mahāprabhu






**Text 8-9** 

Lord Śrī Kṛṣṇa, the Supreme Personality of Godhead, is the supreme enjoyer in the rāsa dance

Leader of the damsels of Vraja, others are simply His associates

Lord Kṛṣṇa advented Himself as Śrī Caitanya Mahāprabhu with all His eternal associates



**Text 13** 

Śrī Advaita Ācārya - Lord Caitanya's incarnation as a Devotee

Three tattvas [Caitanya Mahāprabhu, Nityānanda Prabhu and Advaita Gosāñi] predominators or masters








**Text 15** 

The three predominators - worshipable by all living entities

Fourth principle [Śrī Gadādhara Prabhu] - Their worshiper




Text 16-17

Innumerable pure devotees of the Lord, headed by Śrīvāsa Ṭhākura, who are known as unalloyed devotees

Text 20-21

Characteristics of Kṛṣṇa - understood to be a storehouse of transcendental love

Storehouse of love certainly came with Kṛṣṇa when He was present, it was sealed

But when Śrī Caitanya Mahāprabhu came with His associates of the Pañca-tattva, they broke the seal and plundered the storehouse to taste transcendental love of Kṛṣṇa

The more they tasted it, the more their thirst for it grew

Text 23

Distributing love of Godhead, Caitanya Mahāprabhu and His associates did not consider who was a fit candidate and who was not, nor where such distribution should or should not take place

They made no conditions





Text 25 & 28

Flood of love of Godhead swelled in all directions - all immersed in that inundation

More the five members of the Pañca-tattva cause the rains of love of Godhead to fall, the more the inundation increases and spreads all over the world



Very expert in avoiding the Kṛṣṇa consciousness movement and therefore the inundation of Kṛṣṇa consciousness cannot touch them impersonalists

fruitive workers

false logicians

blasphemers

Text 29-32



Lord Caitanya thought, "I wanted everyone to be immersed in this inundation of love of Godhead, but some of them have escaped. Therefore I shall devise a trick to drown them also."

After accepting sannyāsa order - Śrī Caitanya Mahāprabhu attracted the attention of all those who had evaded Him Beginning with the logicians

infidels, fruitive workers

critics

Text 35-37 & 39

All came to surrender unto the lotus feet of the Lord

All converted - Devotees of Lord Caitanya, even mlecchas and yavanas

Only the impersonalist followers of Śańkarācārya evaded Him

No interest in the study of Vedānta

Engages in chanting and dancing in sankīrtana

Illiterate sannyāsī


Does not know His real function

Guided only by His sentiments

Keeps company of other sentimentalists

Merely smiled to Himself


Rejected all these accusations

Did not talk with the Māyāvādīs

Neglecting the accusation

Proceeded to Mathurā

Later returned to meet the Varanasi Māyāvādīs


Text 43-44

Stayed at the house of Candraśekhara (regarded as a śūdra or kāyastha)

Lord is completely independent.

Accepted His food at the house of Tapana Miśra

Never mixed with other sannyāsīs, nor accepted invite







Text 50-51

Candraśekhara and Tapana Miśra said "How long can we tolerate the blasphemy by Your critics against Your conduct?

We should give up our lives rather than hear such blasphemy.

The Māyāvādī sannyāsīs are all criticizing Your Holiness

We cannot tolerate hearing such criticism - breaks our hearts."

Text 52-54

Śrī Caitanya Mahāprabhu only smiled slightly and remained silent

Brāhmaṇa came there to meet the Lord

"My dear Lord, I have invited all the sannyāsīs of Benares to my home. My desires will be fulfilled if You also accept my invitation"





Text 58-59

Lord Śrī Caitanya Mahāprabhu went to the house of that brāhmaṇa - saw all the sannyāsīs of Benares sitting there

Śrī Caitanya Mahāprabhu - offered obeisances, and then washed His feet - sat down by the place where He had done so

Text 60-61

Caitanya Mahāprabhu exhibited His mystic power - manifested an effulgence as brilliant as the illumination of millions of suns

Sannyāsīs saw the brilliant illumination - body of Śrī Caitanya Mahāprabhu

Minds were attracted

They all immediately gave up their sitting places and stood in respect.





Text 62-63

The leader of Māyāvādī - Prakāśānanda Sarasvatī - addressed Lord Caitanya Mahāprabhu as follows

"Please come here. Please come here, Your Holiness. Why do You sit in that unclean place? What has caused Your lamentation?"

Text 64-65

The Lord replied, "I belong to a lower order of sannyāsīs. Therefore I do not deserve to sit with you."

Prakāśānanda Sarasvatī - caught Śrī Caitanya Mahāprabhu personally by the hand and seated Him with great respect in the midst of the assembly.





Text 67-68

"You belong to our Śaṅkara-sampradāya and live in our village, Vārāṇasī

Why then do You not associate with us? Why is it that You avoid even seeing us?

"You are a sannyāsī. Why then do You indulge in chanting and dancing, engaging in Your saṅkīrtana movement in the company of fanatics?



Text 69-70

Meditation and the study of Vedānta are the sole duties of a sannyāsī

Why do You abandon these to dance with fanatics?

You look as brilliant as if You were Nārāyaṇa Himself

Will You kindly explain the reason that You have adopted the behavior of lower-class people?
